## 1) Problem.

- a. Discuss all of the current issues with our existing government and the sources to those issues. We have to know what is wrong in order to fix it!

## 2) Solution:

  - i. States submit applications on specific topics.

  - ii. Congress aggregates by topic.
  - iii. When 34 states call for a convention on the same topic, Congress calls the convention at a certain date and location.
  - iv. Commissioners Selected and Instructed.
    - 1. Each state selects Commissioners to send
    - 2. Each state instructs their delegates
      - a. Discuss "Faithful Delegate" Laws.
  - v. Commissioners meet at the appointed place and date.
  - vi. Commissioners use "one-state, one-vote" to select a leader.

- vii. Commissioners use "one-state, one-vote" to set rules.
- viii. Commissioners propose, review and approve amendments
  - 1. Amendments not germane to the convention applications are excluded.
  - 2. Amendments are reviewed and modified.
  - 3. Amendments receiving a majority vote of the states are approved.
- ix. When all proposed amendments have been approved (or rejected), the convention is closed and approved amendments are sent to Congress
- x. Congress selects ratification methods for each amendment
- xi. Ratification begins in the states.
- xii. Note: Throughout all of the above, we need to discuss Rob Natelson's research on how the conventions prior to 1787 were run.
- b. Discuss other possible solutions and why they won't work:
  - i. "Teach more people about the constitution"
  - ii. "Elect Better Officials",
  - iii. Nullification
  - iv. Interposition
  - v. Secession
- c. Organized Article V efforts (brief review / overview / status). Describe the groups behind the effort and the odds for success.
  - i. Balanced Budget Amendment
  - ii. COS
  - iii. WolfPac
  - iv. etc.
- d. Possible Amendments
  - i. Note: I don't believe we can just say "trust us, there are many good amendments would could be passed". I know that at the same time we should not support specific amendments / wording. We don't want the COS shot down because we are supporting specific wording which could be challenged. We need to at least discuss some ideas for some amendments.
  - ii. This would be a great place to collect and discuss ideas.
  - iii. Include (at least), a link to Mark Levin's Liberty Amendments
  - iv. Tie each into the three areas in the COS call (showing they are germane): term limits, power and jurisdiction of federal government and fiscal contraints.
  - v. Categorize the ideas in some way -- maybe by branch of government.
  - vi. List amendments which would NOT be germane (e.g., protection for the Bill of Rights)
