WORDPRESS TOOLS & PLUGINS

No matter what you want to do with your blog, chances are there is a Wordpress Plugin available for it! Just keep in mind that plugins can slow down your site, so only install those you absolutely need.

- **Akismet** – “Akismet checks your comments against the Akismet Web service to see if they look like spam or not and lets you review the spam it catches under your blog’s “Comments” admin screen.”
- **Antispam Bee** – “another popular solution to fight spam”
- **Backup Buddy** – “Sites get hacked every day. Our passwords are rarely as strong as we think. And sometimes it doesn’t matter. Sometimes we (or our clients) delete the wrong file or make a change that breaks something. Ever trigger a fatal error from a bad plugin? Crashes happen. But with BackupBuddy, recovering from a problem is quick and easy.”
- **Book Table** - “MyBookTable allows you to have your own bookstore that links to online bookstores where visitors can buy the book.”
- **Bottom of Every Post** – “This plugin does one thing, and that thing is to add some content to the end of each of your posts. This change happens on the fly, so if you deactivate or uninstall this plugin, the feature goes away.”
- **Cachify** – “Smart but efficient cache solution for WordPress. Use DB, HDD, APC or Memcached for storing your blog pages. Make WordPress faster!”
- **Comment Reply** – “Simply notifies comment-author via email if someone replies to his comment. Zero Configuration”
- **Co-Schedule** – “Save time and grow traffic by scheduling blog posts and social media together right from WordPress”
- **EasyAzon** - “EasyAzon 4 is a powerful Amazon Affiliate WordPress plugin that will help you make more commissions and save you a lot of time in the process.”
- **Easy Recipe** - EasyRecipe makes it easy to enter, format and print recipes, as well as automatically doing the geeky stuff needed for Google’s Recipe View.
- **Edit Flow** – “Edit Flow gives you custom statuses, a calendar, editorial comments, and more, all to make it much easier for your team to collaborate within WordPress.”
- **Editorial Calendar** – “The Editorial Calendar makes it possible to see all your posts and drag and drop them to manage your blog.”
- **Filament Flare** – “Spread your content further with the Flare sharing bar. It’s customizable, gorgeous on mobile devices & easy to install on any website.”

- **Genesis Responsive Slider** – “This plugin allows you to create a simple responsive slider that displays the featured image, along with the title and excerpt from each post.”
- **Genesis Simple Hooks** - “This plugin creates a new Genesis settings page that allows you to insert code (HTML, Shortcodes, and PHP), and attach it to any of the 50+ action hooks throughout the Genesis Theme Framework, from StudioPress.”
- **Google Analytics Dashboard** – “Google Analytics Dashboard gives you the ability to view your Google Analytics data in your WordPress dashboard. You can also allow other users to see the same dashboard information when they are logged in or embed parts of the data into posts or as part of your theme.”
- **Google Publisher Plugin** – “The Google Publisher Plugin enables you to easily use Google’s products - including Webmaster Tools - with your WordPress site.”
- **Google Universal Analytics** – “Adding Google Analytics code to your website has never been easier. Simply copy and paste your tracking code or property ID and that’s it.”
- **Gravity Forms** – “Gravity Forms is hands down the best contact form plugin for WordPress powered websites. Build and publish your WordPress forms in just minutes. No drudgery, just quick and easy form-building. Select your fields, configure your options and easily embed forms on your WordPress powered site using the built-in tools.”
- **Hybrid Connect** - Allows you to quickly and easily create customized opt-in boxes, but also allows you to create multiple versions of the same box and then automatically tests them against each other to select the one that has the highest conversion rate.
- **Insert Code Manager** – “This plugin allows you to insert html, css, javascript and PHP code to public WordPress pages.”
- **Instagram Slider Widget** – “Instagram Slider Widget is a responsive slider widget that shows 20 latest images from a public Instagram user.
- **MaxBlogPress Ninja Affiliate** – “Ninja Affiliate is WordPress plugin developed to imbue lethal marketing powers into your WordPress blog and instantly double or triple your affiliate marketing commissions with almost no effort on your part. Using Ninja Affiliate, you can automatically convert any keyword in your blog to an affiliate link instantly. You can also cloak your affiliate links, track them and manage them right from your WordPress text editor.”
- **Nrelate** – “The best way to display related content from your site, and/or your blogroll. nrelate is not just another related posts plugin. Our patent-pending technology continuously analyzes your website content and displays other related posts from your website. This ultimately leads to higher page-views for your site, and a better user experience for your visitors.”
- **Pretty Link** – “*Pretty Link Pro* is a Plugin for WordPress that will enable you to shrink, cloak, track, organize, share and test all of your links on your own domain and server.”

- **PinIt Button Pro** - “Do you want to attract an insane amount of traffic to your WordPress site from Pinterest? Then you need an easy-to-setup eye-catching “Pin It” button that will make visitors want to spread your awesome content.”
- **Redirection** – “Redirection is a WordPress plugin to manage 301 redirections, keep track of 404 errors, and generally tidy up any loose ends your site may have. This is particularly useful if you are migrating pages from an old website, or are changing the directory of your WordPress installation.”
- **Regenerate Thumbnails** – “Regenerate Thumbnails allows you to regenerate the thumbnails for your image attachments. This is very handy if you’ve changed any of your thumbnail dimensions (via Settings -> Media) after previously uploading images or have changed to a theme with different featured post image dimensions.”
- **Related Posts** – “Automatically added Related Posts can increase your internal traffic up to 10%. Just install and activate. To attract attention and improve SEO, link out to Related Posts across the web from your compose screen. Search for posts and hand-pick them with ease. Recommendations are provided by Zemanta’s world-class semantic service. Plugin supports different styles, thumbnails, is fully customizable and includes caching for improved performance.”
- **Smush It** – “Reduce image file sizes and improve performance using the Smush.it API within WordPress.”
- **Social Warfare** — “A WordPress plugin that adds beautiful, lightning-fast social share buttons to your website or blog.”
- **Tablepress** – “TablePress is a *free* WordPress plugin that enables you to create and manage tables on your site. No HTML knowledge is required, as a comfortable interface allows to easily edit table data. Tables can contain any type of data, even formulas that will be evaluated. An additional JavaScript library can be used to add features like sorting, pagination, filtering, and more for site visitors.”
- **Theia Post Slider** - “Our one-of-a-kind Theia Post Slider for WordPress transforms your multi-page posts into slideshows, making them much more engaging and easier to browse.”
- **Tweetily** – “Tweetily, by Flavio Martins, will randomly select a post or page and tweet it automatically to drive traffic to your site. You set the time, number of tweets, and the type of content to share and Tweetily will do the rest.”
- **Ultimate Nofollow** – “This plugin contains several tools in one package to significantly increase your control of the rel=“nofollow” tag on every link on your blog, on both an individual and categorical basis. It is designed to give you fine-grained control of linking for SEO purposes.
- **Updraft Plus** – “Backup and restoration made easy. Complete backups; manual or scheduled (backup to S3, Dropbox, Google Drive, Rackspace, FTP, SFTP, email + others).”

- **Vaultpress** – “VaultPress makes it easy to keep an up-to-date backup of your site with both daily and realtime syncing of all your WordPress content. To ensure your site stays safe, VaultPress performs security scans daily and makes it easy to review and fix threats.”
- **W3 Total Cache** – “The **only** WordPress Performance Optimization (WPO) framework; designed to improve user experience and page speed.”
- **Why Do Work Adsense** – “WhyDoWork Adsense is a WordPress plugin that allows you to insert Adsense ads on your blog without modifying the template. More than that, you can set it up to show different Adsense ads for articles older than X days (x is the number of days you decide). For example, you can insert a 468x60 ad at the bottom of a new article, and once that article turns 7 days old it will have a more aggressive 336x280 ad blended with the text from the beginning of that article. This way your regular readers will not be bothered by your ads, while visitors coming to older posts from search engines or other sources, will see a version that is monetized better.”
- **Wordfence Security** — “Secure your website with the most comprehensive WordPress security plugin. Firewall, malware scan, blocking, live traffic, login security & more.”
- **WP Supercache** – “This plugin generates static html files from your dynamic WordPress blog. After a html file is generated your webserver will serve that file instead of processing the comparatively heavier and more expensive WordPress PHP scripts.”
- **WP Touch** - WPtouch is a mobile plugin for WordPress that automatically enables a simple and elegant mobile theme for mobile visitors of your WordPress website.
- **WWSGD** – “I built this WordPress plugin to implement Seth Godin's idea. It reduces the “work at first” to almost nothing. By default, new visitors to your blog will see a small box above each post containing the words “If you're new here, you may want to subscribe to my RSS feed. Thanks for visiting!” After 5 visits the message disappears. You can customize this message, its lifespan, and its location. The message can be excluded from certain pages if desired.”
- **Yoast SEO** – “Yoast WordPress SEO is the most complete SEO plugin available for WordPress. It offers everything you need to optimize your site.”
