Why do I love the Book of Mormon?

The short answer: it changes me every time I read it.

The longer answer: I have received a witness of the truthfulness of the Book of Mormon repeatedly as I've read it throughout my life. We're promised in Moroni, that we can have our own witness of the Book of Mormon. That the Holy Ghost will bear witness to us of its truth. We even excitedly invite others to act on this same promise so they too can have their own witness.

3 Behold, I would exhort you that when ye shall read these things, if it be wisdom in God that ye should read them, that ye would remember how ^amerciful the Lord hath been unto the children of men, from the creation of Adam even down until the time that ye shall receive these things, and ^bponder it in your ^chearts.

4 And when ye shall receive these things, I would exhort you that ye would ^aask God, the Eternal Father, in the name of Christ, if these things are not ^btrue; and if ye shall ask with a ^csincere heart, with ^dreal intent, having ^efaith in Christ, he will ^fmanifest the ^gtruth of it unto you, by the power of the Holy Ghost.

5 And by the power of the Holy Ghost ye may ^aknow the ^btruth of all things.

Moroni 10:3-5

I have felt the unmistakable confirming peace and warmth of the Holy Spirit in response to my heartfelt, fervent prayer of: is it true? Since Father in Heaven doesn't typically communicate vocally in response to prayer, He sends the answers through the third member of the Godhead, the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost whispers to each of God's children the truth of the divinity of Jesus Christ as well as other eternal truths.

I can explain to you the way the Spirit speaks to me, but that might not be the way He speaks to you. Part of the spiritual journey we're all on is learning to understand and translate the promptings and impressions God grants us through the Holy

Ghost. We must learn this vital skill for our spiritual survival. Satan will attempt to use counterfeit feelings and impressions to confuse us. Satan can make a counterfeit of virtually everything except for **peace**. Peace can only come from God. So although the Spirit might communicate to each of us in varying ways, peace is always part of the communication.

Your spiritual relationship with God and your testimony are between you and God, but if you're seeking truth, know that God is peace. When you seek for answers and feel like you're not sure of the answer, wade through the confusion to decipher what brings peace and what doesn't.

"Satan offers counterfeit alternatives to all that God does in an attempt to confuse and deceive us. Despite Satan's attempts to convince us otherwise, the Savior teaches us that "a corrupt tree [cannot] bring forth good fruit" (3 Nephi 14:18). Because Satan is a corrupt tree, he cannot cause us to feel "love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance" (Galatians 5:22–23). Rather, Satan wants to make us miserable (see 2 Nephi 2:27)."
